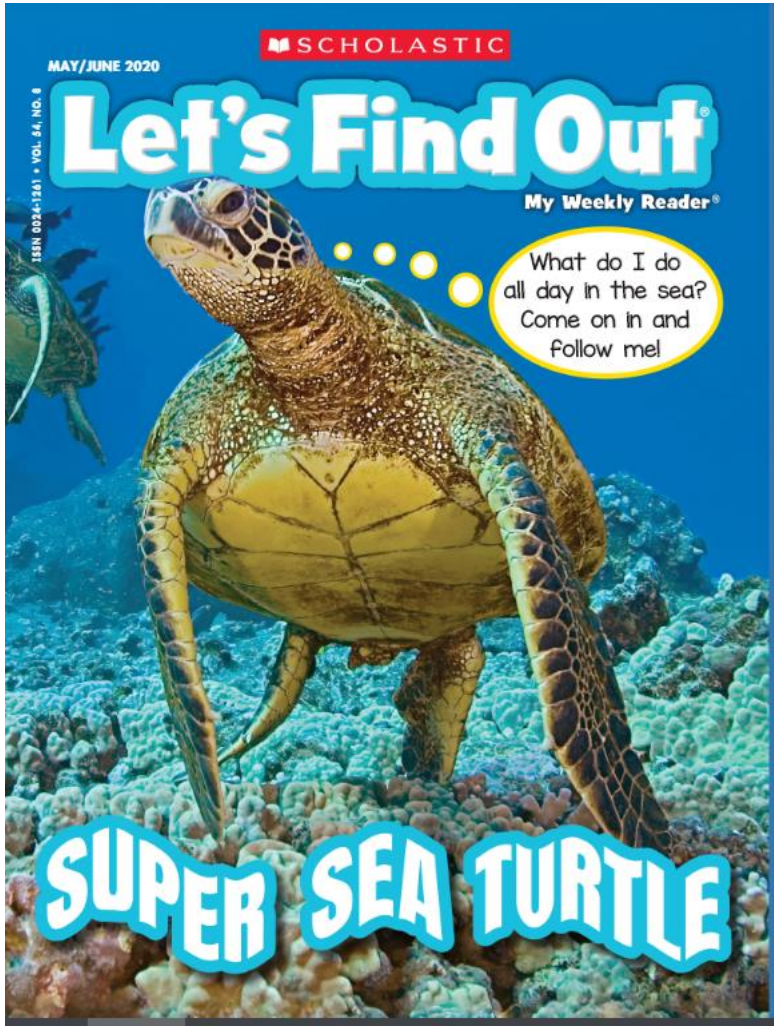

Tang fish eat tiny plants that grow on the turtle's shell and body.

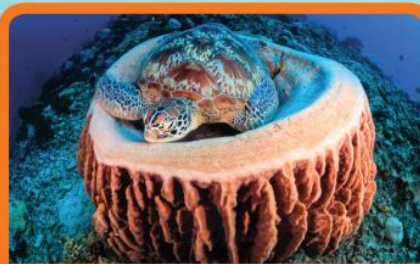
Slow down, sea turtle. These little fish will clean you up! Tickle, tickle.



It is time to come up for air. Take a deep breath. Ahh!



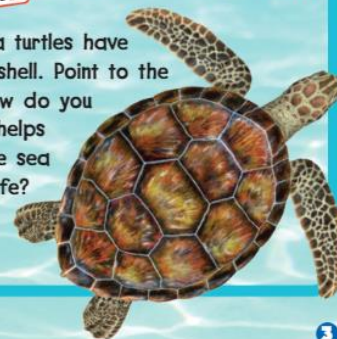
Are you hungry? Dive down. Eat some sea grass. Munch, munch!
